CROP Walk

CROP Walk is coming up on Sunday, October 17. We will have three walks to choose from: a half mile stroll down to the duck pond and back for small children with their parents, a two mile walk through town to St. Mark’s Episcopal Church and back, and for the adventurous, a six mile walk over the bridges on Dune Road.

To support the walk, give a donation to one of the walkers. You could give cash, but a check is better, made out to CWS/CROP or to Westhampton Presbyterian with CROP in the Memo line.
